Please note: Afternoon sessions or full days can be completely funded, morning only funded sessions will incur an additional charge of £2 per session. (voluntary contribution)

Funded early education for some children from 9 months is also available subject to eligibility and availability.

Any additional hours booked above the funding will be charged at the normal hourly rate for the child's age.

We offer all children a mid morning and a mid afternoon snack, breakfast can be provided at an additional cost of £2.50, hot lunch for £3.50 and a cold tea for £2.50, alternatively, you are welcome to provide your own food from home

3 – 4 years extended funding (30 hours)	30 hour entitlement for eligible three and four year olds are from: 8am – 1pm, 1pm – 5pm or 1pm – 6pm Funding can be stretched across 48 weeks of the year using up to 24 hours funding per week or term time only for 38 weeks of the year using up to 30 hours per week					

Please note: A £4.80 charge will be applied to all 3 and 4 year old booked sessions (morning and afternoon) which encompasses the children's enrichment programme (this is a voluntary contribution, *see T & C's for details*)

All children aged three years and over are entitled to a maximum of 15 hours Nursery funding from the government the term following their third birthday. Subject to eligibility and availability we also offer the 30 hour funding. Funded early education for some children from 9 months is also available subject to eligibility and availability.

Any additional hours booked above the funding will be charged at the normal hourly rate for the child's age.

We offer all children a mid morning and a mid afternoon snack, breakfast can be provided at an additional cost of £2.50, hot lunch for £3.50 and a cold tea for £2.50, alternatively you may provide your own.
